This mean that from that date, practices are able to release all areas of your medical record, including documents and test results (once they have been assessed and filed by your practice).



Any new patients will also not have this access, unless they complete a form provided by the admin team. We as practice have taken the Opt-in approach to ensure safety and manage the demand.

Please be aware that this is only for Prospective/future documents, so if you haven't attended the practice after the 31.10.2023, you will not see any information.
